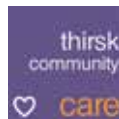

Thirsk Community Care provides support to older people in Thirsk and the surrounding area through the following services:

Befriending: We help people who are rurally and/or socially isolated, living on their own or who have no close family in the area. You will be matched with a volunteer who will spend time with you on a regular or adhoc basis. The volunteer can make home visits or take you out for a cup of tea or a visit to the shops.

Lunch Club: You will have the opportunity to meet weekly for lunch and enjoy activities and games. The Club meets every Monday and the first Thursday of each month.

Social car scheme: If you do not have access to transport you can get support from a volunteer driver who can take you to health appointments, social events, or the shops when required. The service is available every day of the week throughout the day, depending on volunteers' availability.



The following services are available in Thirsk only:

Meals on wheels: You can get a two-course hot meal delivered to your door by a volunteer. This service gives you a healthy and nutritious meal as well as regular contact with a volunteer. The service costs £5 for a two-course meal.

Supported Shopping: The shopping scheme can help you visit the local shops. Our minibus will pick you up from your home and volunteers will join you to help read labels, reach the shelves and carry your shopping.
